Boil Water Notice Rescinded June 18, 2025

On June 08,2025, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the Hickory Creek SUD/Randolph WSC public water system, TX1160062/TX0740027, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently in the public water system, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.
